Dear Parents/Carers,

We have had a high number of staff test positive for Covid over the weekend in addition to several members of staff who are still testing positive beyond the 5 day self-isolation period. There is a significant number of lessons to cover and a limited supply of external cover supervisors available. I now need to move to one year group working at home for a day this week in order to ensure we can cover the classes in school using our own staff.

The plan for the remainder of the week is for the following year groups to work at home on these days:

On the day your child is working at home, we expect them to **logon to TEAMs at 9am** for a year group assembly led by their Head of Year. The work for the lessons timetabled on that day will be set on class charts. We will endeavour to make wellbeing phone calls during the day to ensure your child is able to access the work. I recognise the disruption to learning and very much hope that it will only be necessary to put this plan in place for this week. I will write with an update at the end of the week.

In the meantime, we will continue to wear face-masks in all communal areas and teaching spaces at school. It is also important that we all continue with the lateral flow testing.
